Important Message regarding Handicaps

The primary goal of our club is to conduct fair and fun competitions each week. Assuring honest and accurate handicaps for everyone is essential. Members should be diligent by assuring their own handicap is accurate. Simply follow the guidelines below:

1. Do not post your score for FEGC events. The Handicap Chairman will post those for you. Members are responsible for posting all other scores.
2. Ensure that you post from the correct tees.
 - (a waiver from Regular Tee's forward , must have board approval)
3. Adjust your score according to the USGA Equitable Stroke Control system below:

Your Current Handicap Index	Maximum Score on any hole
0- 9	Double Bogey
10-19	7
20-29	8
30-39	9
40+	10

4. Post an accurate adjusted score for every single round of golf that you play as soon as possible after the round. *(Every round, every course, whether you played well or not)*
 - Peer Review: It is everyone's responsibility, as a member of FEGC, to assist the club by assuring accurate handicapping for all members. If you are aware of any member that is not posting some scores or is not posting accurately, you should notify a Board member.
